Parent Survey Results

In March parents were asked to share feedback regarding the School Development Plan, School Budget and Fees. Results are preliminary but we are happy to share the following results.

Around 50 responses were received.

96% Strongly Agreed or Agreed that their child's learning can benefit from the goals and strategies outlined in the School Development Plan.

81% Strongly Agreed or Agreed that the learning of all students is reflected in the goals and strategies in the School Development Plan.

100% Strongly Agreed or Agreed that the Activities the school provide (field trips, guest speakers, experts in school, sporting activities, outdoor education) are important for my child's learning.

96% Strongly Agreed or Agreed that school fees are reasonable considering the benefit they provide my child.

There were a variety of written comments provided. We are currently editing/organizing the comments in a way that makes sense for sharing and using to help inform us as a school.
